'Nobody' to hold rally

The "Nobody For President" campaign is coming to Santa Fe and will rally between noon and 2 p.m. Tuesday at River Park.

Nobody made a first, unsuccessful bid for the White House in 1976, but this year Nobody's fool and campaign manager, Wavy Gravy, predicts Nobody will win by a landslide.

"After all, Nobody can win the war in the Middle East, right?" said local coordinator Reno Kleen.

Wavy Gravy, a noted master of ceremonies from the famed Woodstock Festival, clown and satirist,

kicked off Nobody's campaign recently in San Francisco. Kleen said the rally there was attended by thousands, and was covered by all major media, including the foreign press.

"Nobody and his campaign are on a whistle stop tour of the states," Kleen said, "and will wind up in Washington, D.C., on election day."

The campaign has visited Boulder, Colo., where rumor has it Gov. Dick Lamm endorsed Nobody, Kleen said. Future stops are scheduled for Austin, Texas, and points east.
